**AN ACT REQUIRING HEALTH INSURERS TO DISCLOSE  
EXPERIENCE DATA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) Each insurer, health care  
2 center, hospital and medical service corporation or other entity  
3 delivering, issuing for delivery, renewing, continuing or amending any  
4 group health insurance policy in this state on or after October 1, 2007,  
5 shall disclose to any employer, upon request of the employer, its  
6 experience data including, but not limited to, claims paid, losses,  
7 administrative costs and profits.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>October 1, 2007</i>	New section
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**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide information that would allow businesses to make an informed choice in group health care insurance plans.
