***AN ACT CONCERNING HIV/AIDS TESTING OF INMATES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 54-102a to 54-102c, inclusive, of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require persons who are sentenced to incarceration to be
- 3 tested for the presence of the etiological agent for acquired immune
- 4 deficiency syndrome or human immunodeficiency virus upon entering
- 5 a correctional facility and upon release from incarceration unless such
- 6 person affirmatively refuses to be tested or such person has already
- 7 tested positive for HIV/AIDS.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require HIV/AIDS testing of inmates so that appropriate services may be offered.
