**AN ACT REQUIRING THE TAKING OF A DNA SAMPLE FROM  
PERSONS ARRESTED FOR SERIOUS CRIMES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require DNA testing of all
- 2 persons arrested for a major or violent felony or for a sexual offense
- 3 and require that the resulting DNA profile be compared against state
- 4 and national DNA databases.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To facilitate the apprehension of criminals and prevent them from perpetrating future crimes by requiring the DNA testing of persons arrested for certain serious crimes.
