AN ACT CONCERNING VISITATION RIGHTS WITH PARENTS FOR CHILDREN IN THE CARE AND CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17a-10 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the Commissioner of Children and Families shall not suspend a
- 3 child's visitation rights with his or her parents without an evidentiary
- 4 hearing, except in the case of an emergency.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that the Department of Children and Families shall not suspend a child's visitation rights with parents without an evidentiary hearing.
