AN ACT CONCERNING AN ENERGY INDEPENDENCE ECONOMIC PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 3 renewable energy sources and, using current appropriations, use the
- 4 Department of Public Utility Control's existing programs to attract
- 5 alternative energy and renewable energy businesses to the state.
