**AN ACT CONCERNING RECIPROCAL LICENSING OF PERSONS  
ENGAGED IN SERVICING RECEIVING EQUIPMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (b) of section 20-350 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to allow the Department of Consumer Protection to issue a
- 3 license without examination to any person who, at the time of the
- 4 application or within thirty days prior thereto, was licensed to engage
- 5 in servicing receiving equipment by another state under a law which
- 6 contained qualifications substantially similar to those contained in the
- 7 general statutes in this state, when the other state grants reciprocity to
- 8 persons licensed in this state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow the Department of Consumer Protection to issue a reciprocal license to a person engaged in servicing receiving equipment.
