**AN ACT CONCERNING THE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR
APPLYING TO TAKE THE CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT EXAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-281c of the general statutes be amended to specify
- 2 that an applicant may take the certified public accountant examination
- 3 if the applicant holds a baccalaureate degree, or its equivalent,
- 4 conferred by a college or university acceptable to the Department of
- 5 Consumer Protection, with an accounting concentration or its
- 6 equivalent.

Statement of Purpose:

To specify when an applicant is eligible to sit for the certified public accountant exam.
