**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR FILING AN
AFFIDAVIT IN LIEU OF ADMINISTRATION IN THE PROBATE OF A
SMALL ESTATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 45a-273 of the general statutes be amended to increase,
- 2 from twenty thousand dollars to forty thousand dollars, the maximum
- 3 value of property of a decedent that qualifies for the filing of an
- 4 affidavit in lieu of an application for admission of a will to probate.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the threshold for filing an affidavit in lieu of administration in the probate of a small estate.
