**AN ACT CONCERNING ADDITIONAL CREDITED SERVICE IN THE
CONNECTICUT TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-183e of the general statutes, concerning additional
- 2 credited service in the Connecticut teachers' retirement system, be
- 3 amended to: (1) Eliminate the ten-year cap on the amount of additional
- 4 credited service that can be purchased; (2) allow the purchase of one
- 5 year of out-of-state service for each year of in-state service; (3) treat
- 6 teaching service in other states as Connecticut teaching when
- 7 computing the proratable retirement benefit under said system, and (4)
- 8 allow two additional months of credited service per year for school
- 9 administrators who work twelve months per year.

Statement of Purpose:

To modify provisions in the Connecticut Teachers' Retirement Act relating to credit for out-of-state teaching service in order to be more consistent with neighboring states.
