AN ACT CONCERNING REMOVAL OF A CHILD FROM A HOSPITAL IN CERTAIN JUVENILE MATTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46b-129 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that no order may be made or revoked by the court that permits a child
- 3 to be removed from a hospital or other health care facility unless the
- 4 court holds an evidentiary hearing on the issue of such removal.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that no order may be made or revoked by the court with regard to certain juvenile matters to permit a child to be removed from a hospital or other health care facility unless the court holds an evidentiary hearing on such removal.
