AN ACT CONCERNING TOWNS THAT RECEIVE LESS THAN FIFTY PER CENT OF THEIR EDUCATION BUDGET FROM THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to hold every town
- 2 that receives less than fifty per cent of its education budget from the
- 3 state harmless to any cuts.

Statement of Purpose:

To hold every town that receives less than fifty per cent of its education budget from the state harmless to any cuts.
