AN ACT ESTABLISHING A HEALTH LITERACY TASK FORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to identify measures to be used in
- 2 assessing the health literacy of Connecticut residents and health care
- 3 providers and to evaluate the direct or indirect impact of health
- 4 literacy on adults and children in order to develop specific goals and
- 5 strategies for improving the health of Connecticut residents.

Statement of Purpose:

To appoint a task force to study the health literacy of Connecticut residents and identify strategies for improving health literacy and, ultimately, the health of Connecticut residents.
