AN ACT CONCERNING THE PREVENTION OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the state shall contract with nongovernmental agencies to
- 2 develop a coordinated response system to prevent human trafficking
- 3 and that the sum of one hundred thousand dollars be appropriated in
- 4 fiscal year 2007 and the sum of one hundred thirty thousand dollars be
- 5 appropriated in fiscal year 2008 for the purposes of implementing
- 6 such contract.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize funding for training and outreach to prevent human trafficking.
