***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SECURITY ASSISTANCE FOR
EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
2 Security Assistance for Education Grant Program to provide
3 reimbursement to school districts for security assessments, security
4 infrastructure, portable security devices and training related to new
5 security equipment; and to amend the school construction grant
6 program to require that applicants for new school buildings,
7 renovations, extensions or replacements that involve entryways

- 8 include plans for security infrastructure in their applications.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a Security Assistance for Education (SAFE) Schools grant to help school districts pay for new or updated school security equipment and related training.
