**AN ACT TO REDUCE THE OVERALL TAX PER GALLON ON FUEL  
PURCHASED AT THE PUMP.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a special account be established for receipts derived from the
- 2 Attorney General's investigation of gasoline price gouging and the
- 3 revenues received by the state from the gross receipts tax on gasoline,
- 4 which, due to unanticipated sharp increases in gasoline prices, were in
- 5 excess of estimated revenues at the time of enactment; that money in
- 6 the fund would be used to reduce the overall tax per gallon that
- 7 motorists pay at the pump.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To help reduce the overall fuel tax paid at the pump.
