***AN ACT CONCERNING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF STATE MARSHALS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 6-32 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):

3 (a) Each state marshal shall (1) receive each process directed to such  
4 state marshal when tendered, execute [it] such process promptly and  
5 make true return thereof; and [shall,] (2) without any fee, give receipts  
6 when demanded for all civil process delivered to such state marshal to  
7 be served, specifying the names of the parties, the date of the writ, the  
8 time of delivery and the sum or thing in demand. If any state marshal  
9 does not duly and promptly execute and return any such process or  
10 makes a false or illegal return thereof, such state marshal shall be liable  
11 to pay double the amount of all damages to the party aggrieved.

12 (b) State marshals shall be reimbursed by the state for all reasonable  
13 and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
