***AN ACT PROHIBITING THE IDLING OF MOTOR VEHICLES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any motor vehicle  
2       from operating more than three consecutive minutes when such  
3       vehicle is not in motion, except when necessary due to traffic  
4       conditions, when operating heating, cooling or auxiliary equipment  
5       located in or on the vehicle, when attempting to bring the vehicle to  
6       the manufacturer's recommended operating temperature, when the  
7       exterior temperature is below twenty degrees Fahrenheit, when at  
8       certain drive-in facilities, when undergoing maintenance or when  
9       being inspected by United States military personnel, and to make a  
10      violation of this section an infraction.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To prohibit the idling of any automobile or truck.
