**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISPOSITION OF POSSESSIONS OF A DECEASED TENANT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That subsection (d) of section 47a-11d of the general statutes be  
2 amended to replace the reference to section 47a-42 of the general  
3 statutes concerning the process for removing and storing a deceased  
4 tenant's possessions with either (1) a reference to the process in section  
5 47a-11b of the general statutes concerning removal and storage of a  
6 tenant's abandoned possessions, or (2) a process for removal and  
7 storage of possessions upon order of the Probate Court.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To revise the process for disposing of a deceased tenant's possessions in order to address situations when the tenant's next of kin fails to claim such possessions.
