AN ACT REQUIRING A REVERSE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER WARNING SAFETY SYSTEM AT ALL AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINES AND SATELLITE DEVICES IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) (a) An automated teller
2 machine or satellite device established or used in this state shall be
3 designed and programmed so when a consumer enters his or her
4 personal identification number in reverse order, the automated teller
5 machine or satellite device automatically sends an alarm to the local
6 law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the automated teller
7 machine or satellite device location. No difference between an
8 emergency transaction and a normal transaction shall be detectable
9 from the machine or device.

10 (b) The Banking Commissioner may adopt regulations, in
11 accordance with chapter 54 of the general statutes, to implement the
12 provisions of subsection (a) of this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
