AN ACT CONCERNING THE FREQUENCY OF PAYCHECKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 31-71i of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):

3 The commissioner may, upon application, waive the provisions of
4 section 31-71b with respect to any particular week or weeks, and may
5 also, upon application, permit any employer, subject to the provisions
6 of this section, to establish regular pay days less frequently than
7 weekly, provided (1) each state employee affected shall be paid in full
8 at least once in each calendar month on a regularly established
9 schedule, and (2) each nonstate employee affected shall be paid in full
10 at least [once] bi-weekly in each calendar month on a regularly
11 established schedule.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require that employees, other than state employees, be paid at least bi-weekly.
