***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL INTERNSHIP PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Commissioner of  
2 Administrative Services shall establish and manage, within available  
3 appropriations, a State Cooperative Educational Internship Program to  
4 provide qualified students with practical training opportunities at state  
5 agencies in the areas of social services, health care, engineering, human  
6 resources, finance, computer science and any other occupational  
7 groups, as determined by said commissioner. The intern positions  
8 established under such program shall be temporary positions, outside  
9 the classified service and shall be available only to students currently  
10 enrolled in an associate's, bachelor's, or master's degree program at an  
11 accredited college or university located within the state.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
