AN ACT PROVIDING ESSENTIAL PLANNING FOR CATASTROPHIC EVENTS IMPACTING THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Commissioner of
2 Administrative Services, within available appropriations, shall
3 establish a program to ensure business continuation for the state in the
4 event of a pandemic flu or other catastrophic event that impacts the
5 state workforce or critical state operations. Such program shall
6 include, but not be limited to, ongoing planning to address situations
7 in which some or all of the state workforce is unable to report to work
8 and training of state employees on such program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
