**AN ACT ALIGNING THE FOOD STAMP PROGRAM MOTOR VEHICLE
RULE WITH THE CARE4KIDS MOTOR VEHICLE RULE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 17b-105a of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2007*):

4 (b) The Commissioner of Social Services shall implement [the
5 federal option to allow applicants for, or recipients of, food stamps to
6 retain a car valued up to the limit established under the temporary
7 family assistance program] vehicle evaluation provisions in
8 accordance with 7 CFR 273.8(f)(4).

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following

Statement of Purpose:

To allow the Commissioner of Social Services to implement a federal
option that will allow the commissioner the ability to align the food

stamp motor vehicle rule with the less restrictive motor vehicle rule used in determining Care4Kids program eligibility.
