AN ACT CONCERNING THE AVAILABILITY OF ELECTRONIC RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Commissioner of Motor
2 Vehicles may permit any licensed motor vehicle dealer to maintain, in
3 an electronic format prescribed by the commissioner, all records,
4 documents and forms required by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
5 Such records, documents and forms shall be produced in written
6 format, not later than three business days, upon request by the
7 department.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To permit licensed motor vehicle dealers to electronically store all records required by the Department of Motor Vehicles, provided such dealer shall produce any such record, in written form, no later than three business days upon request by the department.
