AN ACT CONCERNING REBATE CARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2007*) A consumer may use a
2 rebate card for store credit or a cash refund from the business that
3 issued the rebate card. For purposes of this section, "rebate card"
4 means an instrument authorizing purchases on credit for which a
5 deduction from the amount to be paid or a return of part of an amount
6 to be given in payment is made.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2007</i>	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To allow consumers greater options concerning the use and redemption of rebate cards.
