**AN ACT ALLOWING ELECTROLOGISTS TO USE LASER TECHNOLOGY FOR HAIR REMOVAL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (1) of section 20-267 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2007*):

4 (1) "The practice of electrology" means the permanent removal of  
5 superfluous hair by electrical, laser or other methods approved by the  
6 Commissioner of Public Health.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
