***AN ACT CONCERNING INTERIOR DESIGNERS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 20-377n of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, no person  
4 shall be issued a certificate of registration as an interior designer unless  
5 such person submits satisfactory proof that such person has passed (1)  
6 [the] a uniform national examination established by the National  
7 Council for Interior Design Qualifications or the Council for  
8 Qualification of Residential Interior Designers, or (2) any other  
9 examination with standards or requirements equal to or greater than  
10 those established by such [council] councils, provided the  
11 requirements of this subsection shall not apply to an architect licensed  
12 in this state.

13 (b) The commissioner may issue a certificate of registration as an  
14 interior designer, without examination, to any person who is currently  
15 registered or licensed in another state having registration or licensing  
16 standards or requirements equal to or greater than the standards or

17 requirements established in sections 20-377k to 20-377v, inclusive.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow persons who pass a uniform national examination established by the Council for Qualification of Residential Interior Designers to register as interior designers.
