**AN ACT CONCERNING PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 20-300 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2007*):

3 There shall be in the Department of Consumer Protection a State  
4 Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors,  
5 which shall consist of twelve persons appointed by the Governor, three  
6 of whom shall hold licenses as professional engineers, two of whom  
7 shall hold combined licenses as professional engineers and land  
8 surveyors, four of whom shall be public members and three of whom  
9 shall hold licenses as land surveyors. The members holding licenses as  
10 professional engineers, the members holding the combined licenses  
11 and the public members shall administer the provisions of this chapter  
12 as to licensure and issuance, reissuance, suspension or revocation of  
13 licenses concerning the practice of professional engineering. The  
14 members holding licenses as land surveyors, the members holding the  
15 combined licenses and the public members shall administer the  
16 provisions of this chapter as to licensure and issuance, reissuance,

17 suspension or revocation of licenses concerning the practice of land  
18 surveying. The Governor may remove any member of the board for  
19 misconduct, incompetence or neglect of duty. The members of the  
20 board shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be  
21 reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of  
22 their duties. The board shall keep a true and complete record of all its  
23 proceedings. The Commissioner of Consumer Protection, with advice  
24 and assistance from the board, shall adopt regulations in accordance  
25 with chapter 54 (1) concerning professional ethics and conduct  
26 appropriate to establish and maintain a high standard of integrity and  
27 dignity in the practice of the profession, [and] (2) for the conduct of the  
28 board's affairs and for the examination of applicants for a license, and  
29 (3) concerning the revision of educational and experience requirements  
30 for licensure of professional engineers and land surveyors.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To conform professional engineer and land surveyor educational and experience licensing requirements to present practice.
