**AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Commissioner of  
2 Consumer Protection shall review the programs administered by the  
3 Department of Consumer Protection in order to: (1) Evaluate the cost-  
4 effectiveness and benefits of such programs; and (2) assign priority for  
5 the continued funding of such programs. The commissioner shall  
6 submit findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee  
7 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to  
8 appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not later than January  
9 1, 2008, and annually thereafter.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
