"AN ACT CONCERNING MANUFACTURER PERMITS FOR BREW PUBS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (f) of section 30-16 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (f) A manufacturer permit for a brew pub shall allow: (1) [the] The
7 manufacture, storage and bottling of beer, (2) the retail sale of alcoholic
8 liquor to be consumed on the premises with or without the sale of
9 food, [and] (3) the selling at retail from the premises of sealed bottles
10 or other sealed containers of beer brewed on such premises for
11 consumption off the premises, and (4) the sale of sealed bottles or other
12 sealed containers of beer brewed on such premises to the holder of a
13 wholesaler permit issued pursuant to subsection (b) of section 30-17,

14 provided that the holder of a manufacturer permit for a brew pub
15 produces at least five thousand gallons of beer on the premises
16 annually. Such selling at retail from the premises of sealed bottles or
17 other sealed containers shall comply with the provisions of subsection
18 (d) of section 30-91 and shall permit not more than eight liters of beer
19 to be sold to any person on any day on which such sale is authorized
20 under the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91. The annual fee
21 for a manufacturer permit for a brew pub shall be two hundred forty
22 dollars."
