**"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC HEALTH STATUTES AND REVISING THE SCOPE OF
PODIATRIC MEDICINE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) For the fiscal years ending June 30,
4 2008, and June 30, 2009, there shall be allocated to the Department of
5 Mental Health and Addiction Services, from the Tobacco and Health
6 Trust Fund, any balance remaining in said trust fund after transfers
7 required by law have been made from the amount disbursed to said
8 fund from the Tobacco Settlement Fund pursuant to subdivision (2) of
9 subsection (c) of section 4-28e of the general statutes. Such funds shall
10 be used by the department to provide grants for tobacco education
11 programs designed to discourage smoking by minors in grades one to
12 eight, inclusive. The department shall ensure that such education

13 programs are funded on a state-wide basis and shall establish
14 reporting requirements for grantees of such funds."
