"RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW SEVENTEEN-YEAR-OLD PERSONS WHO WILL BE EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE AT THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION TO VOTE IN PRIMARIES RELATED TO SUCH ELECTION."

1 In line 11, strike "or on the day of a primary held for such regular"
2 and insert the following in lieu thereof: ". Any citizen who has not yet
3 attained the age of eighteen years of age but who will have attained the
4 age of eighteen years on or before the day of a regular election, who is
5 otherwise qualified to be an elector and who has applied for admission
6 as an elector in such manner as may be prescribed by law, may vote in
7 any primary election, in such manner as may be prescribed by law,
8 held for such regular election."
