**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE
RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF STATE ETHICS
CONCERNING MUNICIPAL ETHICS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 1-83 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (b) (1) The statement of financial interests, except as provided in
7 subdivision (2) of this subsection, shall include the following
8 information for the preceding calendar year in regard to the individual
9 required to file the statement and the individual's spouse and
10 dependent children residing in the individual's household: (A) The
11 names of all businesses with which associated; (B) [the category or
12 type of] all sources of income, including the name of each employer,
13 with a description of each source, in excess of one thousand dollars,
14 without specifying amounts of income; (C) the name of securities in
15 excess of five thousand dollars at fair market value owned by such
16 individual, spouse or dependent children or held in the name of a
17 corporation, partnership or trust for the benefit of such individual,
18 spouse or dependent children; (D) the existence of any known blind
19 trust and the names of the trustees; (E) all real property and its
20 location, whether owned by such individual, spouse or dependent
21 children or held in the name of a corporation, partnership or trust for
22 the benefit of such individual, spouse or dependent children; (F) the
23 names and addresses of creditors to whom the individual, the
24 individual's spouse or dependent children, individually, owed debts of
25 more than ten thousand dollars; (G) any leases or contracts with the
26 state held or entered into by the individual or a business with which he
27 or she was associated; and (H) a description of any partnership, joint
28 ownership or similar business affiliation between (i) a business
29 included under subparagraph (A) of this subdivision with which the
30 individual filing the statement, the individual's spouse or a dependent
31 child of the individual is associated, and (ii) a lobbyist, a person that
32 the individual filing the statement knows or has reason to know is
33 doing business with or seeking to do business with the state or is
34 engaged in activities that are directly regulated by the department or

35 agency in which the individual is employed, or a business with which
36 such lobbyist or person is associated.

37 (2) The statement of financial interests filed by state marshals shall
38 include only amounts and sources of income earned in their capacity
39 as state marshals.

40 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
41 subsection (a) of section 1-83 of the general statutes, any person
42 required to file a statement of financial interests on or before May 1,
43 2007, as described in subsection (b) of section 1-83 of the general
44 statutes, as amended by this act, shall file a supplemental statement of
45 financial interests not later than August 1, 2007, which states the name
46 of each employer of such person. The Office of State Ethics shall
47 prescribe the form for such supplemental statement not later than June
48 15, 2007, and notify each person subject to the provisions of section 1-
49 83 of the general statutes, as amended by this act, of the requirements
50 of this section."
