"AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO HEALTH AND NUTRITIONAL INFORMATION IN RESTAURANTS."

1 Strike lines 3 to 14, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(1) "Restaurant" means any entity, other than a grocery store, that is
4 licensed, permitted, registered or inspected as a food service
5 establishment by a local health department or district health
6 department pursuant to section 19-13-B42 of the regulations of
7 Connecticut state agencies."

8 After line 30, insert the following:

9 "(6) "Grocery store" means any store commonly known as a
10 supermarket, food store or grocery store, primarily engaged in the
11 retail sale of all sorts of prepackaged, canned and dry goods such as
12 tea, coffee, spices, sugar and flour, either packaged or in bulk, with or

13 without fresh fruits and vegetables, and with or without fresh, smoked
14 and prepared meats, fish and poultry."

15 In line 67, strike "such calorie" and insert "the total number of
16 calories per serving per item" in lieu thereof

17 In line 68, strike "totals"

18 In line 76, strike "director of health,"

19 In line 77, strike "or registered sanitarian" and before "inspection",
20 insert "regularly scheduled"

21 In line 78, strike "whether standard printed menus, menu boards or"
22 and insert "the chain restaurant's compliance with said provisions." in
23 lieu thereof

24 Strike lines 79 and 80 in their entirety

26 In line 98, strike "January 1, 2008" and insert "July 1, 2008" in lieu
