21 "Sec. 7. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Department of Economic
22 and Community Development shall enter into and maintain a
23 memorandum of understanding with the Connecticut Center for
24 Advanced Technology regarding the administration of the provisions
25 of grant programs pursuant to sections 2 to 6, inclusive, of this act.
26 Such memorandum of understanding shall include, but not be limited
27 to, detailed duties and responsibilities of the Connecticut Center for
28 Advanced Technology regarding sections 2 to 6, inclusive, of this act.
29 The Department of Economic and Community Development, in
30 consultation with the Connecticut Center for Advanced Technology,
31 shall submit an annual report regarding grant programs established
32 pursuant to sections 2 to 6, inclusive of this act and the memorandum
33 of understanding required pursuant to this section, in accordance with
34 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint
35 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
36 matters relating to energy and technology and the environment."
