"AN ACT CONCERNING TOURISM DISTRICT REPRESENTATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a
4 Connecticut Music Hall of Fame Committee that shall develop a plan
5 for the creation and operation of a Connecticut music hall of fame in
6 order to recognize distinguished Connecticut residents in the field of
7 music. The committee shall consist of the following members:

8 (1) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

9 (2) One appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;

10 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of

11 Representatives;

12 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;

13 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
14 Representatives; and

15 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate.

16 (b) All appointments to the committee shall be made no later than
17 thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall be
18 filled by the appointing authority.

19 (c) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
20 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairperson of the committee,
21 from among the members of the committee. Such chairperson shall
22 schedule the first meeting of the committee, which shall be held no
23 later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.

24 (d) The plan developed by the committee shall include, but not be
25 limited to, a recommendation for the location for the music hall of
26 fame, criteria for induction of residents into the music hall of fame, and
27 rules concerning the operation of the music hall of fame. Not later than
28 February 1, 2008, the committee shall submit a report to the joint
29 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
30 matters relating to commerce concerning such plan.

31 (e) The committee may solicit, receive and accept aid, grants or
32 contributions, from any source, of money, property, labor or other
33 items of value for the purposes of this section."
