**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT
HEALTH CENTER."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) (a) The Office of Health Care
4 Access shall, within available appropriations, contract with the
5 Connecticut Academy of Science and Engineering to conduct a needs-
6 based analysis of The University of Connecticut Health Center facilities
7 plan. Such analysis shall consider (1) a comparison of the center's
8 proposal for a replacement hospital with the alternative plan for a
9 remodeled center, (2) the projected state-wide need for hospital beds
10 up to at least the year 2018, and any possible impact that any acute
11 care hospital in the region may experience if the amount of beds is
12 increased at the university hospital, (3) the center's need for a
13 modernized academic medical facility to provide instruction and
14 achieve excellence in the schools of medicine and dental medicine and
15 program in biomedical science, attract medical and biomedical

16 professionals to such schools and program and to support research
 17 and clinical trials, and (4) other factors that the academy may deem
 18 appropriate.

19 (b) Not later than March 30, 2008, the Connecticut Academy of
 20 Science and Engineering shall issue a preliminary report and not later
 21 than June 30, 2008, the academy shall issue a final report, in accordance
 22 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, of its
 23 analysis pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to the joint standing
 24 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
 25 relating to higher education, public health, commerce, finance, revenue
 26 and bonding and appropriations."
