- 1 After subsection (b) of section 501, insert the following:
- 2 "(c) Prior to the commencement of any activities on the
- 3 approximately 131.4 acres, more specifically described as 0 Biddle Pass
- 4 in the town of Plainville, and subsequent to the lessee receiving all
- 5 necessary federal, state and municipal approvals to commence
- 6 extraction or reservoir development activities on such site, the lessee
- 7 shall obtain deed restrictions for a minimum of twice the acreage that
- 8 has been approved for extraction activities, which restrictions (1)
- 9 prohibit the use and development of such acreage adjacent to such site
- 10 for anything other than open space purposes, (2) permanently dedicate

11 such acreage for land uses such as public parks or forests or natural
12 areas, including, but not limited to, reservoirs, (3) require such acreage
13 to be preserved predominantly in its natural scenic and open space
14 condition that may allow for camping, hiking, forestry, fishing,
15 wildlife or natural resource conservation, and (4) prohibit all other
16 building or development except as may be required for source
17 protection and to meet water quality standards, if used as a public
18 water supply."
