"AN ACT CONCERNING RULES OF COURT."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 51-88 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (a) A person who has not been admitted as an attorney under the
7 provisions of section 51-80 or who is not otherwise providing legal
8 services pursuant to any statute or rule of court shall not: (1) Practice
9 law or appear as an attorney-at-law for another, in any court of record
10 in this state, (2) make it a business to practice law, or appear as an
11 attorney-at-law for another in any such court, (3) make it a business to
12 solicit employment for an attorney-at-law, (4) hold himself out to the
13 public as being entitled to practice law, (5) assume to be an attorney-at-
14 law, (6) assume, use or advertise the title of lawyer, attorney and
15 counselor-at-law, attorney-at-law, counselor-at-law, attorney,

16 counselor, attorney and counselor, or an equivalent term, in such
17 manner as to convey the impression that he is a legal practitioner of
18 law, or (7) advertise that he, either alone or with others, owns,
19 conducts or maintains a law office, or office or place of business of any
20 kind for the practice of law."
