Title: AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE TO RESTORE THE MILL RIVER IN THE CITY OF STAMFORD.

Statement of Purpose: To provide funds to Stamford to (1) restore over four miles of the Mill River, which is a spawning habitat for endangered anadromous fish species including blueback herring and alewife, (2) facilitate the creation of a greenbelt through downtown providing nonvehicular access to Long Island sound, and (3) create a Mill River Park in the city.
