**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM CARE POLICIES.

**Statement of Purpose:** To require an insurance company, fraternal benefit society, hospital service corporation, medical service corporation or health care center selling long-term care policies in the state of Connecticut to notify all insureds under a long-term care policy of the company, society, corporation or center's intent to discontinue new sales of such long-term care policy not less than sixty days prior to discontinuing such sales.
