Title: AN ACT CONCERNING HEATING OIL AND PROPANE GAS CHARGES.

Statement of Purpose: To: (1) Require certain heating oil and propane delivery contracts to be written in plain language and allow such contracts to be in electronic form, (2) prohibit surcharges or fees from being added to the delivery price of heating oil or propane, subject to certain conditions, (3) allow heating oil and propane companies to assess certain fees, charges and penalties if they are conspicuously disclosed at the time the contract is made, and (4) provide that liquidated damages cannot exceed actual damages suffered by a heating oil or propane company due to a consumer breach.
