Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE CLOSURE OF THE CONNECTICUT JUVENILE TRAINING SCHOOL AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF REGIONAL TRAINING, REHABILITATION AND EDUCATION CENTERS.

Statement of Purpose: To provide for the establishment of a pilot program for community-based services for children in the juvenile justice system who have been committed to the Department of Children and Families, and the establishment of regional training, rehabilitation and education centers for the residential placement of highest-risk male juvenile offenders, in anticipation of the planned closing of the Connecticut Juvenile Training School.
