**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC INSURANCE FILINGS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To provide for electronic-only filing of annual and quarterly financial statements by a foreign insurer to be made instead of requiring hard copy; to provide for electronic-only filing of annual financial audits by a foreign insurer to be made instead of requiring hard copy; to revise the "health care" definition to more accurately define the range and categories of health care services to be provided through the health care centers; to revise the definition of "health care center" to reflect current models using individual practice arrangements and carve-outs of ancillary services and to bring all prepaid arrangements rendering health care services by any health care professional for treatment of injury, illness or disease under the regulatory authority of the Insurance Department; to amend purposes and activities of health care centers which are no longer required as a result of amendments to sections 38a-175 and 38a-176 of the general statutes; to repeal section 38a-177 of the general statutes which is an unnecessary provision; to provide authority to adopt regulations for viaticals for other than terminally ill persons; to harmonize the eligibility requirements for Medicare supplement policies to include not only age and disability but also end stage renal disease; and to provide for electronic-only filing of annual and quarterly financial statements by foreign fraternal societies to be made instead of requiring hard copy.
