Title: AN ACT REQUIRING A DISCLOSURE STATEMENT WHEN A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCY REQUESTS AN INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER.

Statement of Purpose: To protect an individual's privacy and reduce the opportunity for identity theft by enacting provisions consistent with the Federal Privacy Act of 1974 to require state and local agencies, including state colleges and universities, that request an individual's Social Security number to disclose whether providing such number is mandatory or voluntary, the authority for making such request and the uses to which such number will be made.
