**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING PENALTIES FOR CONCEALING EMPLOYMENT OR OTHER INFORMATION RELATED TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION PREMIUMS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To provide that employers who misrepresent the number or type of employees for purposes of paying a lower premium for workers' compensation insurance may be issued a stop work order and required to pay one thousand dollars per day for violation of the stop work order.
