**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING THE DATE OF BIRTH OF ADOPTED PERSONS BORN OUTSIDE OF THE COUNTRY AND NOTICE PROVIDED BY THE COUNCIL ON PROBATE JUDICIAL CONDUCT.

**Statement of Purpose:** To (1) allow the courts of probate to issue a decree regarding the date of birth of an adoptee born outside of the country if the parent of such adoptee, or the adult adoptee, provides medical and other evidence to establish that such birth date is inaccurate, and to require the court to provide notice of the decree to the Department of Public Health in order for birth records to be amended accordingly, and (2) provide that notice provided by the Council on Probate Judicial Conduct to a complainant that a judicial misconduct investigation has been terminated be given seven days, rather than three days, after the termination of such investigation.
