**"AN ACT CONCERNING CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS MADE TO ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS."**

1 Change the effective date of sections 1 and 2 to "Effective from  
2 passage"

3 After line 28, insert the following:

4 "Sec. 3. Subsections (h) and (i) of section 9-610 of the general statutes  
5 are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
6 *from passage*):

7 (h) No communicator lobbyist, member of the immediate family of a  
8 communicator lobbyist, or political committee established or  
9 controlled by a communicator lobbyist or a member of the immediate  
10 family of a communicator lobbyist shall make a contribution or  
11 contributions to, or for the benefit of (1) an exploratory committee or a  
12 candidate committee established by a candidate for nomination or  
13 election to the office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney  
14 General, State Comptroller, State Treasurer, Secretary of the State, state

15 senator, [or] state representative or a public official, as defined in  
16 section 1 of this act, (2) a political committee established or controlled  
17 by any such candidate, (3) a legislative caucus committee or a  
18 legislative leadership committee, or (4) a party committee.

19 (i) No communicator lobbyist, immediate family member of a  
20 communicator lobbyist, agent of a communicator lobbyist, or political  
21 committee established or controlled by a communicator lobbyist or any  
22 such immediate family member or agent shall solicit (A) a contribution  
23 on behalf of a candidate committee or an exploratory committee  
24 established by a candidate for the office of Governor, Lieutenant  
25 Governor, Attorney General, State Comptroller, State Treasurer,  
26 Secretary of the State, state senator, [or] state representative or a public  
27 official, as defined in section 1 of this act, a political committee  
28 established or controlled by any such candidate, a legislative caucus  
29 committee, a legislative leadership committee or a party committee, or  
30 (B) the purchase of advertising space in a program for a fund-raising  
31 affair sponsored by a town committee pursuant to subparagraph (B) of  
32 subdivision (10) of section 9-601a.

33 Sec. 4. Subsections (g) and (h) of section 9-610 of the general  
34 statutes, as amended by public act 06-137, are repealed and the  
35 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2007*):

36 (g) No communicator lobbyist, member of the immediate family of a  
37 communicator lobbyist, or political committee established or  
38 controlled by a communicator lobbyist or a member of the immediate  
39 family of a communicator lobbyist shall make a contribution or  
40 contributions to, or for the benefit of (1) an exploratory committee or a  
41 candidate committee established by a candidate for nomination or  
42 election to the office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney  
43 General, State Comptroller, State Treasurer, Secretary of the State, state  
44 senator, [or] state representative or a public official, as defined in  
45 section 1 of this act, (2) a political committee established or controlled  
46 by any such candidate, (3) a legislative caucus committee or a  
47 legislative leadership committee, or (4) a party committee.

48 (h) No communicator lobbyist, immediate family member of a  
49 communicator lobbyist, agent of a communicator lobbyist, or political  
50 committee established or controlled by a communicator lobbyist or any  
51 such immediate family member or agent shall solicit a contribution on  
52 behalf of a candidate committee or an exploratory committee  
53 established by a candidate for the office of Governor, Lieutenant  
54 Governor, Attorney General, State Comptroller, State Treasurer,  
55 Secretary of the State, state senator, [or] state representative or a public  
56 official, as defined in section 1 of this act, a political committee  
57 established or controlled by any such candidate, a legislative caucus  
58 committee, a legislative leadership committee or a party committee."
