After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Department of Public Safety

shall study the impact of the legalization of palliative marijuana use in Rhode Island and shall analyze (1) the impact on Rhode Island local
