**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2007*) The Department of Public Safety  
4      shall study the impact of the legalization of palliative marijuana use in  
5      Montana and shall analyze (1) the impact on Montana local and state  
6      police departments of the enforcement of fraudulent claims associated  
7      with such legalization, and (2) the overall increase of arrests for the  
8      illegal use of marijuana in Montana. On or before February 1, 2008, the  
9      department shall report its findings and recommendations to the joint  
10     standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of  
11     matters relating to public safety, in accordance with the provisions of  
12     section 11-4a of the general statutes."
